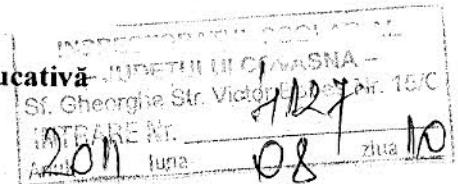

Una dintre fișe va fi atașată pe spatele lucrării, cealaltă va fi pusă în plic, alături de lucrare. Fișele și lucrările trebuie trimise la adresa „The National centre of art creativity of children and youth”, 16, Kirov Street, Minsk 220030, Republic of Belarus, până la data de **10 septembrie 2011**.

### **3<sup>rd</sup> International children's art contest "Children's friendship around the globe"**

The Ministry of Education of the Republic of Belarus continues the project of the international art contest "**Children's friendship around the globe**". The previous two contests gathered the art works of more than 1400 children from 12 countries: Azerbaijan, Armenia, Belarus, Bulgaria, Kirgizia, Latvia, Lithuania, Moldova, Russia, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, the Ukraine.

#### **The aims of the 3<sup>rd</sup> International contest are:**

- to get acquainted with life and culture of people around the world;
- to strengthen the international and cultural relationship;
- to cultivate the responsibility for present and future of the world in the young generation;
- to reveal and support young talents.

2. **Contest organizers are** Ministry of Education of the Republic of Belarus and the National center of art creativity of children and youth with the support of the Belarusian Union of Artists.

3. **Contest participants are** children and young people between age 6 and 16 years. The works for the contest can be presented by institutions and organizations as well as by individuals. Only individual works can participate in the contest, and there should be no more than 2 art works from each participant.

#### **4. Requirements for works are:**

1. The graphic works and paintings for the contest can be of any art technique.

2. Work's themes are:

- "The world I live in",
- "My family and me",
- "My friends",
- "My hobbies",
- "My country".

3. Format of works should be no more than 50x70 cm

4. Works should be unframed.

5. The following information form should be attached to each work:

6. Information form should be filled in with block letters in English, Russian or Belarusian languages in 2 copies, one of which should be attached to the back of the work.

Works without the information forms will be not accepted.

It is possible to add more information to the work, e.g. photos of the participant. This information will be used at exhibition arrangement.

7. Works are received before 10 September 2011.

8. Send your works to the following address: 16, Kirov street, Minsk, 220030, Belarus, the National center of art creativity of children and the youth.

**5. Selection of the art works:**

5.1. The contest works will be judged by professional jury consisting of professional artists, leading pedagogues of art, members of the Belarusian Union of Artists.

5.2. Works will be judged in four age groups: 6-8 years old, 9-10 years old, 11-13 years old, and 14-16 years old and in nominations – "graphics" and "painting".

5.3. The winners and prize-winners will be awarded with medals and diplomas of the Ministry of Education of the Republic of Belarus (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> degree) and catalogues in each age group and nomination; participants whose works will be selected for the exhibition will receive diplomas of the Belarusian Union

of Artists, diplomas of the National centre of art creativity of children and the youth.

5.5. The works for this contest are not returned to the participants.

5.6. The exhibition will be arranged from the best art works of the contest and will take place at the exposition hall of the National centre of art creativity of children and the youth in Minsk in October – November, 2011.
